SOS: Support our Speedwatch Team

The Kirkby Stephen Speedwatch campaign is proving to be very successful. Since we started in March 2018 our team has been out on 79 occasions and caught 369 vehicles exceeding the speed limit, mostly on the main route through the town, South Road, North Road and the A685 (40 zone). On the side roads, Nateby Road and Faraday Road, we have been out 15 times and found only one vehicle speeding.

We record the speed of vehicles exceeding the speed limit, noting the time, speed, registration number, make, and colour. These records are passed to the Police who then send a warning letter advising drivers that they have been observed breaking the speed limit. No further action is taken, although if multiple letters are sent, additional Police action may result.

The equipment is made available to us every 6-7 weeks. All volunteers receive initial training in use of the Speedgun from the Police and after practice become part of the team.

More Speedwatch volunteers are needed to join our team, to help ensure that everyone travels through our town within the speed limits, making Kirkby Stephen a safer place for everyone.

If you are interested in joining us, please let the staff in Local Links know and we will endeavour to set up appropriate training.

Kirkby Stephen Town Council has accepted an opportunity to work with ACTion with Communities in Cumbria (ACT) to explore the needs for public transport in our area and find ways of making services sustainable. Over a 6-9 month period ACT will assist the local community to:

Assess local travel needs • Identify services to meet those needs • Produce and action plan to enhance and develop services

The first stage will be for local volunteers to work out current travel patterns, and identify where people would like to travel to if options were available.

The second stage will be to audit existing transport services and to consider other local issues that could affect travel. This would be desk-based research by volunteers assisted by ACT.

The third stage will be to consider possible solutions to transport needs, taking into account the ideas and views of the community, good practice and expertise from elsewhere, and linking with other communities.

The final stage will be to develop an action plan to bring these ideas to fruition.

The programme is obviously dependent on the use of volunteers to work on ideas and solutions for improvement of public transport. A Message From Phil Dew

One of the key responsibilities of the County Council is looking after the welfare of the seven hundred children in care in Cumbria. Councillors are referred to as 'corporate parents' and asked to treat each child as if they were their own.

I have taken on the additional role of Children's Champion for Eden and speak out on issues of concern which are brought to my attention by the children themselves. In the period running up to Christmas I appealed for donations towards Christmas hampers for young people leaving care and setting up home for the first time. The residents of Upper Eden responded very generously and forty two hampers were distributed - each of which was very much appreciated. This is something we hope to continue throughout the year. I also chair the Children and Young People's Working Group which looks at wider issues affecting children and young people in Eden. In that capacity I regularly attend the Eden Youth Council which organises the annual Make Your Mark Ballot that canvases the views of all the secondary school age young people in Cumbria. This year the key concerns in Eden were, unsurprisingly, climate change and mental health. Interestingly, those two issues are linked by a new condition known as 'Eco Anxiety' which results in children feeling depressed and worried about the uncertain future they face. Sufferers have an overwhelming sense of hopelessness and despair which causes sleepless nights and panic attacks.

This condition has been exacerbated by the extreme and emotive language used by adults when voicing their environmental concerns. This achieves nothing and simply fuels anxiety. I would implore people to be more considered in the way they express their views. The truth is that there are plenty of other very real threats to occupy our minds, such as the possibility of a flu pandemic - as evidenced by the coronavirus in China - which could kill millions of people. These are things which we are powerless to influence or change in any significant way. What we should do is strive to make a difference where we are and work together to make the world a better place. I wish you every success in that endeavour.

Voluntary Social Car Scheme in Kirkby Stephen & Brough

This scheme is funded by Cumbria County Council. The scheme provides transport to members of the community of any age (under 16 years must be accompanied by an adult) who cannot make their journey by public or private transport.

Examples of journeys include getting doctors/dentist appointments, shopping, visiting friends & making public transport connections. Passengers pay a contribution towards the cost of the transport. If two or more people travel then the fare is shared between them. Journeys are available depending on volunteer availability. You may be asked to share transport & you may need to be flexible about the time you travel. This February, Upper Eden Community First Responders (UECFR) celebrate ten years supporting residents of the Upper Eden Valley by attending medical emergencies. Members of the team undertake training and assessments by North West Ambulance Service (NWAS) Paramedics, this includes recognising signs of a stroke and a heart attack, how to perform CPR and the use of a defibrillator, oxygen therapy and basic first aid.

Team members are mobilised by NWAS when ambulance assistance is requested to an adult in a state of collapse. The team members are often closer than the ambulance so can get there sooner to offer vital life-saving treatment before the ambulance arrives. Kirkby Stephen is around 45 miles from the nearest accident and emergency department and resources can often be held up taking other patients to hospital. Local 'boots on the ground' provide a genuine benefit to the community in times of distress.

Over the past decade the team has had as many as 20 volunteer responders [and has attended over 1500 incidents], however, due to people relocating and circumstances changing, the team dropped down to seven members covering the area from Kirkby Stephen to Warcop, North and South Stainmore, Mallerstang, Ravenstonedale as far as Fell End plus Newbiggin-on-Lune; an area of over sixty square miles. Fortunately, the team has recently recruited some new members giving a total of nine.

To support the local community, the UECFR team has been working with parish councils to install defibrillators across the area that are accessible to the public if someone has a cardiac arrest. UECFRs fund the cost of the defibrillator and offer Hearstart training to residents on what to do in an emergency, this includes CPR and how to use a defibrillator.

The team are always seeking new recruits, plus, as the team is self-funded and rely on donations, they are always looking at ways of raising funds. For more information please contact the secretary Dave Prince, telephone 07887 683831 or email: secretary@uppereden.org.uk




